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High spatial and temporal resolution ocean colour coastal water products and services

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HIGHROC is a European Union 7th Framework Program (FP7) Collaborative Research Project carried out by a consortium of seven partners with experience in remote sensing and its applications in the management of coastal and estuarine waters.




The overall objective of HIGHROC is to develop new products and services to cater for the requirements of end-users involved in coastal water quality management and/or related activities such as dredging operations and offshore constructions and their environmental impacts. To reach spatio-temporal resolution required by users, HIGHROC derives coastal water quality parameters from Sentinel-2 (S2) at 10-20m resolution and SEVIRI at 15 minutes resolution, thus dramatically improving the spatial and temporal resolution.



- Business development and sustainability




15-min temporal resolution (SEVIRI)




30-m resolution (Landsat 8 OLI)
